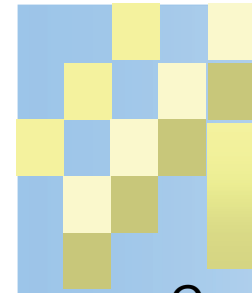

iFolder

Keeping the correct version of current files easily available can be difficult. Novell iFolder solves this problem: getting the files you need where you need them. With iFolder, wherever you are, your files are waiting for you. When you drag & drop your files into your iFolder directory, they will automatically be synchronized to your other workstations or laptop with the iFolder client and backed up to the iFolder server.

Novell iFolder web enables you to access your synchronized files from any location using a web browser.

You have 200 megabytes of iFolder space.

NetStorage

NetStorage allows you to access your Home directory (H: drive), Dropbox, and Dept. shared folder via the web from at home or while traveling. Access is available from any computer with web access, anywhere in the world. There is no need to e-mail or copy files from one machine to another.

Shortcut-Just go to <http://science.smith.edu/NetStorage> to log in.

NetDrive

NetDrive allows you to map a drive on your Computer and connect to your Science server drives. This utility functions like NetStorage but instead of using a web browser, it will map your network drives to a spare drive letter on your PC. Now you can access your Science files and folders from within any program at home, just as if they were on your local computer.

iPrint

iPrint allows Windows users to add print drivers for most printers in the Science Center. In addition, printers are installed with all necessary configurations like duplex and tray settings. You can also quickly add Pharos'ed color laser printers from this page without assistance.

eGuide

eGuide is a fast and efficient utility to search the campus Novell directory for content such as name, department, phone number, and email address.

(Note: while everyone on campus is in eGuide, most people outside the Science Center do not have complete info listed.)

Virtual Office

Virtual Teams adds the ability to collaborate among multiple users with shared folders, a group calendar, group favorites and group discussions.

Create discussion groups on the fly for interaction with colleagues and students. Share files and photos, schedules for upcoming poster sessions, or web links useful to your joint research.
