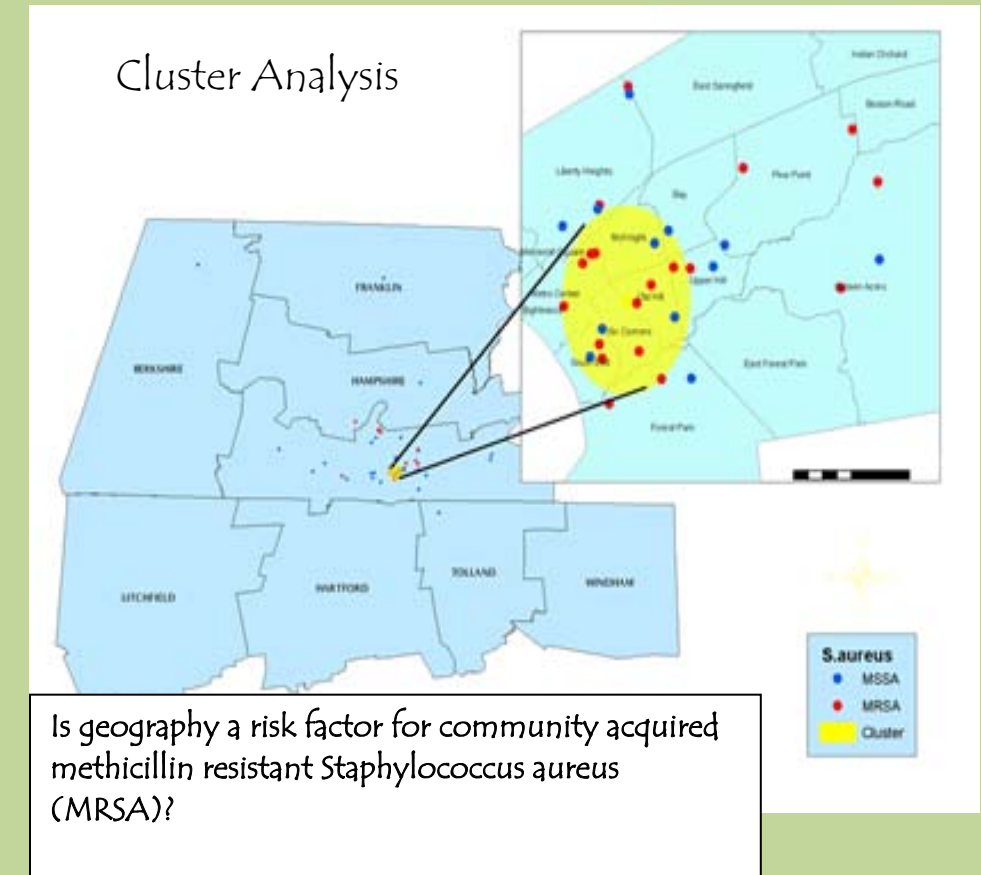
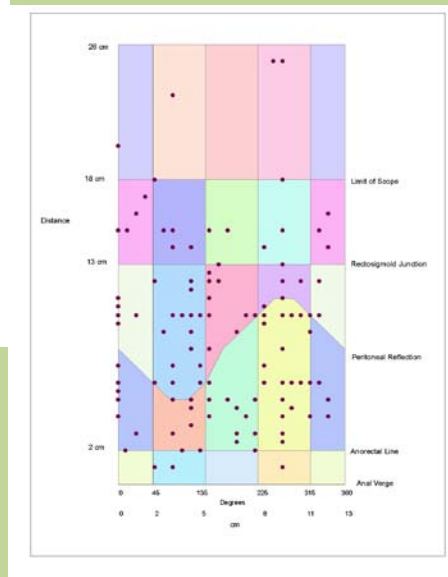
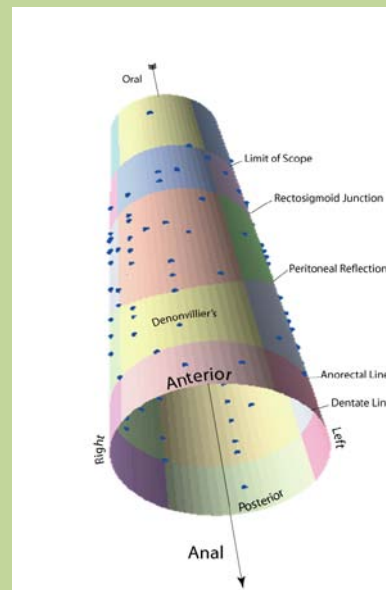
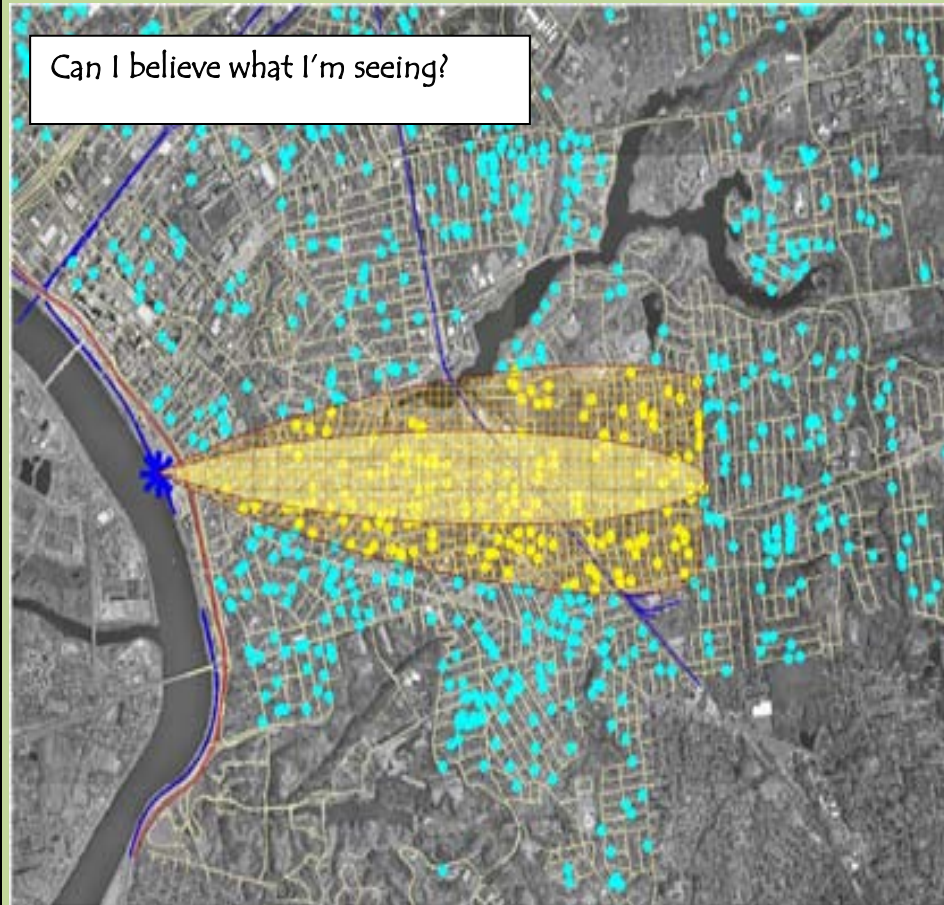


# Spatial Statistics in Health: The Guts Behind the Maps
