

Standard HTML Toolbar Help



Legend / Layer Control: Displays either the legend or the list of layers.



Overview map: Hides or displays the overview map, which is a map of the entire region. When you are zoomed into a region, the overview map displays a regional map with an outline of the current zoom.



Zoom In: Zooms in on the position clicked on or the box dragged on the map. Usually the default tool.



Zoom Out: Zooms out on the position clicked on or the box dragged on the map.



Zoom to Full Extent: Zooms to the full geographic extent of the map.



Zoom to Active Layer: Zooms to the full geographic extent of the active layer.



Zoom to Previous Extent: Zooms to the last previous extent or view. This is especially useful when you have inadvertently gone past the view you would like to see.



Pan: Pans the map using a click and drag of the mouse.



Pan (directional): Pans the map in a North, South, East or West direction.



Identify: Displays a list of attributes for the active layer.



Identify All: The tool will provide information about **ALL** layers (which are checked in the “Visible” box left of each layer name) at the exact location where the browser map is “clicked”. Results from the Identify tool appear below the map.



Query: Creates a query statement that will retrieve and display features on the map.



Find: Finds names or values in the active layer.



Measure: Measures distances between points on the map.



Set Units: Sets the units for the measure tool.



Buffer: Inserts a buffer zone around a feature.



Select by Rectangle: Draws a rectangle around an area and displays an active layer feature in that rectangle.



Select by Line or Polygon: Selects and highlights contiguous features and areas from the active layer along a line the user draws or within a polygon the user draws.



Clear: Unselects the current selection on the map.



Print: Prints a copy of the current map with a legend and a title.
