**Fall 2017 Nomination for a Churchill Scholarship - The Winston Churchill Foundation of the United States awards scholarships of approximately \$45,000-\$50,000 to fund one year of graduate study in the sciences, engineering, and mathematics at the University of Cambridge. Smith seniors or recent graduates who are US citizens may apply. More information: http://www.winstonchurchillfoundation.org.

We ask for your internal application one year in advance because you should apply for a Churchill plus one or more complementary scholarship applications to increase your chances of funding for the UK graduate program of your choice. We want to make sure you have time for the discussion, exploration, and mentoring needed to make a really great set of applications!

**January 2017 Nomination for a Goldwater Scholarship - The Goldwater Scholarship awards up to \$7,500 p.a. to college sophomores and juniors majoring in math, science, engineering, or research psychology (not clinical). Students who are competitive for the award have had significant research experience and have plans for graduate study (aspire to a PhD or MD/PhD) and a career in research. Applicants must be US citizens, US nationals, or US permanent residents. More

**March 2017 Nomination for a Udall Scholarship - The Morris K. Udall and Stewart L. Udall Foundation is committed to increasing awareness of the importance of the nation's natural resources. The Udall Scholarship awards \$7,000 and access to the Udall Scholars network to sophomores and juniors who are passionate about the environment (in any field), OR who are Native American and intend to pursue careers in Native health care or tribal public policy.
